### **ACC:**

2 meetings this month

-9 new permits were approved, 1 of them were for site development.

-0 permit closed.

-Totals: 238 permits

Tanner is continuing contacting members who have active site development projects. Everyone has a unique set of circumstances, and sometimes life gets in the way of schedules and timelines, but we want members to keep working towards completion. 1 member past their site development plan has been fined.

### **Forestry-Nature:**

-5 emergency permits granted to remove dangerous or harmful trees.

-2 forestry permits issued

### **Compliance:**
