OUR AMENITIES AND COMMON AREAS



Please Remember When Using Common Areas and Amenities:

- These are shared spaces, be kind and courteous to others using them.
- Clean up after yourselves and your guests.
- Dogs must be on a leash **AT ALL TIMES** in the Riviera. No dogs allowed to swim at **ANY** of the lake parks. No dogs at Ray Park or Lake Florence side of Interlachen.
- Please remember that you are responsible for the behavior of your guests.



Pierce County Vacation Rental (VR) Requirements

Prior to Renting

- ◆ Provide notification of the presence of the vacation rental to all neighboring property owners directly adjacent to the vacation rental property.
- ◆ File a Vacation Rental Affidavit with the Pierce County Planning and Public Works Department which indicates the following:
 1. Intent to use the residence as a vacation rental
 2. Contact information for the owner or manager of the property
 3. Listing of sites where the rental is advertised
 4. Required neighborhood notification has been provided



For Each Trip

- ◆ No more than a total of ten (10) guests per rental
- ◆ Must provide guests with information indicating the location of guest parking spaces
- ◆ A Good Neighbor brochure for short-term rentals is provided to each renter describing the appropriate etiquette while residing in a VR

Note: These guidelines are for rentals less than 30 days in which compensation is paid for the lodging. If the standards described above are exceeded or otherwise not met, the proposed use may require a Conditional Use Permit from Pierce County.

THE COURSE IS LOOKING GREAT!



Spring is one of the busiest times of the year for the Golf & Grounds crew. This is when we start special projects, while continuing regular maintenance on the Course, Parks, Marina & Campground. This April, our golf course greens, tee boxes, and fairways were able to be aerified one week ahead of time due to cooperative weather. Doing all this at once created less disruption and allows for the course to heal faster. There was a low spot on the #7 fairway which was causing a water collection area that had continued to grow during the winter. We have put in a dry well which should create better drainage. We will be putting up new split rail fencing at both sides of Interlachen Park and at the Campground. We look forward to seeing all of you out enjoying the golf course and recreational areas!

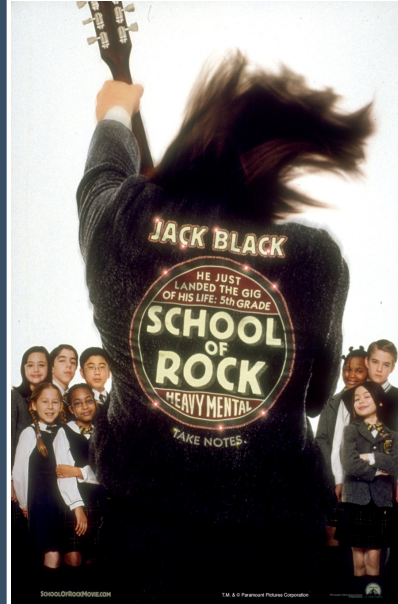
